

**IN-PERSON, INDOOR SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP
RETURNS MAY 16, 2021 @ 10:30 A.M.
ONLINE WORSHIP WILL ALSO CONTINUE WORSHIP**

WORSHIP: We will reopen the sanctuary building for indoor, in-person worship on Sunday mornings, beginning May 16th at 10:30 a.m., with masks required for those who are not fully vaccinated (two weeks after second dose if following a two-dose regime), health screening, limited physical contact, and social distancing measures in place in accordance with CDC recommendations. Safety precautions will include an entry table in the Narthex providing masks to those who need one, a brief health-screening on the honor system, sign-in, pick up of communion elements if you need them, and a place to drop off offerings. Ushers will escort you to socially distanced seating. Sunday school and other meetings will continue to be held online via Zoom at this time, unless specific communications are sent from your group instructing otherwise. Other buildings on the campus remain closed until further notice.

NURSERY: The nursery will reopen for worship on June 6 for babies through entering first grade this fall. Babies and crawlers will be in the nursery location and older kids (3+) will be dropped off and picked up upstairs in room 203/"the upper room" where we'll have more room to spread out. **Reserving a spot:** In order to make sure we have adequate space and volunteers, please reserve a spot for your children by noon on Saturday, before the Sunday service, by emailing Emily Stull at emily.stull@gmail.com.
